## Architectural Request Change (ACC-ARC) Form

The Governing Documents for the Roxborough Reserve Homeowners Association (HOA), given to each owner at settlement, detail the rules that govern the look and feel of the community to retain value for your real estate investment.


The Architectural Request Change (ACC-ARC) form enables Roxborough Reserve homeowners to obtain approval in writing for changes in the look and feel of the community from the Roxborough Reserve HOA Executive Board of Directors prior to beginning construction and/or installation. This includes exterior additions, modifications or alterations such as fencing, driveways, patios, decks, sheds or other structures, windows, paint, exterior finishes, retaining wall changes, etc.

The ARC also helps manage the operation of the Roxborough Reserve infrastructure. Since Roxborough Reserve is in the Schuylkill watershed and includes several basins built specifically for stormwater collection, it is important that construction projects do not negatively affect the integrity of the basin system.

Please complete page two of this form and submit it via the PMI-Greater Philadelphia CINC portal, with all relevant items detailed in the checklist.

Once submitted, PMI/Greater Philadelphia will review to ensure that everything is complete. If something is missing, a member of the team will follow up with you. Once complete, your ACC-ARC submission will appear directly in the Board's portal. The Board will have 5 days to review and process your request. All approvals and denials by the Executive Board will be sent via email and confirmed in the portal.

(Note: Site Plan is available online via RoxRes Resources page.)

\_\_\_\_\_ Certificate of Insurance from the contractors working in the community listing the HOA as additional insured. Contractors should submit workers' compensation insurance and have at least 2 million in liability insurance.

\_\_\_\_\_ A copy of all City Permits required and any other governmental agency that may be required.

\_\_\_\_\_ For patios and any kind of cement or paver work please include confirmation from Rami Ayoub, E.I.T., Philadelphia Water Department, Stormwater Plan Review via [rami.ayoub@phila.gov](mailto:rami.ayoub@phila.gov) that the project won't negatively affect the stormwater basins.
